ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by videoconference on September 10, 2013 at 12:43 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall work within a six (6) month timeframe to particularize the claims of injurious affection, including the exchange and listing of documents.

[2] The Parties shall work within a six (6) month timeframe to decide what statutory instruments and provisions apply to each of the alleged takings set out in the claim. The Parties shall inform the Tribunal of such decision by way of joint memorandum. If agreement cannot be reached, the Parties shall advise the Tribunal of the same.

[3] By agreement and consent of the Parties, proceedings in this claim shall be bifurcated. A draft Order particularizing the bifurcation shall be sent to the Parties no later than Friday, September 13, 2013.

[4] The Parties shall confer to establish five (5) day period for a hearing on the merits of the validity stage of proceedings in May or June, 2014. The Parties shall work with the Registry to confirm and schedule the same at their earliest convenience.

[5] The next CMC in this matter is scheduled for January 16, 2013, at a time and location to be determined. CMC Briefs shall be filed by each party at least five (5) days before the scheduled CMC.
