ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in Vancouver, British Columbia, on October 15, 2013 at 9:50 A.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver).

[1] The Parties shall work together in the preparation of a Common Book of Documents for the purposes of a hearing on the merits of the validity of the claim.

[2] The Respondent shall provide a preliminary draft of an Agreed Statement of Facts to the Claimant on or before December 2, 2013.

[3] The Parties shall consult with each other to seek an agreement on which provisions of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* relating to compensation would apply should there be a finding of validity.

[4] A joint report on the status of the Common Book of Documents, the Agreed Statement of Facts and compensation principles shall be filed on or before December 2, 2013. In the joint report, the Respondent shall advise as to the status of other documentary research, and more specifically, whether they have been completed.

[5] A Section 22 Notice shall be provided to the Province of British Columbia by the Registry.

[6] The claims shall be bifurcated, and an Order to this effect shall follow the next CMC.

[7] The next CMC is scheduled for December 5, 2013, at 3:00 P.M., Pacific Time by teleconference.

[8] The other Akisq'nuk claim (SCT-7003-13) shall be scheduled in conjunction with the present claim (SCT-7006-12) for the next CMC.
