A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held on February 3, 2014, at 9:29 A.M., Mountain Time (Edmonton, Alberta).

[1] The Claimant shall produce and provide to the Respondent a List of Documents and identify which documents were before the Specific Claims Branch not later than March 3, 2014.

[2] The Respondent shall produce and provide to the Claimant a List of Documents not later than March 17, 2014.

[3] The Parties shall inform the Tribunal not later than September 5, 2014: 1) Whether they intend to tender expert reports; 2) if experts are to be tendered, they shall be retained; 3) the names of the experts; and 4) a schedule for the exchange of reports.

[4] The Parties shall discuss and report to the Tribunal if there are any discrete questions to be tried before moving on to a hearing on the merits of the claim at the next CMC.

[5] Pursuant to Section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* (S.C. 2008, c. 22), Notices shall be sent to Sucker Creek First Nation, Swan River First Nation, Kapawe'no First Nation and Sawridge First Nation.

[6] The next CMC is scheduled for June 3, 2014, at 10 A.M., in person or by teleconference, and shall address bifurcation.

[7] The following dates are set for future CMCs: August 8, 2014 at 10 A.M., October 10, 2014, December 18, 2014, and January 16, 2015, and will be subject to change if circumstances dictate.
