[1] A Notice pursuant to Section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* shall be sent by the Tribunal to the Province of British Columbia.

[2] The Parties shall provide the Tribunal with a draft Bifurcation Order on or before **January 23, 2015**.

[3] The Parties shall exchange Lists of Documents on or before **February 27, 2015** subject to any additional documents pursuant to the Respondent's ongoing research. Additional document production and timeframe will be addressed at the next CMC.

[4] The Claimant shall provide the Respondent with a draft Agreed Statement of Facts and a draft Agreed Statement of Issues by mid- February, **February 16, 2015**. The Respondent shall provide its response to the above on or before **February 27, 2015**.

[5] The Claimant shall notify in writing to the Respondent and the Tribunal on or before **February 27, 2015** if it intends to present oral history evidence.

[6] The Claimant does not yet know whether expert evidence shall be submitted. The Respondent intends to produce an Expert Report. Each Party shall notify the Tribunal and each other in writing of its intention to retain or not an expert and, in the affirmative, shall notify the Tribunal in writing of the name of their respective expert on or before **February 27, 2015**.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **March 16, 2015**, at 4:45 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
