ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by videoconference on November 25, 2013 at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall discuss and report at the next CMC whether they have agreed on a threshold issue and on the facts required to be in evidence for determination of that issue.

[2] The Parties shall advise at the next CMC whether they agree that documents presented by the Claimant during the Specific Claims Branch process will be included in the Common Book of Documents. They shall also further advise of any issues of admissibility in evidence of those documents.

[3] The Respondent shall advise whether there are additional documents other than those provided by the Claimant during the Specific Claims Branch process, and the Respondent shall make efforts to disclose such documents as they become available. The Respondent shall make ongoing disclosure at reasonably convenient intervals, despite the possibility that their research may not be complete.

[4] The Parties shall report at the next CMC on whether they plan to retain experts or rely on Expert Reports during the hearing.

[5] The next CMC will be scheduled for mid-March, 2014, at a date and time to be coordinated by the Registry. Joint CMC Briefs are acceptable if there are matters that Counsel can report on jointly.

[6] The Claimant will prepare and provide a draft work plan to the Respondent in approximately four (4) weeks.
