ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 1, 2014, at 2:00 P.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver).

[1] The Parties agreed to hold the next CMC jointly with *Skuppah Indian Band v Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada* (SCT-7004-13) (“*Skuppah*”). The next CMC is currently

scheduled to be held in person in Vancouver on Friday, **February 13, 2015** at 2:00 P.M., Pacific Time.

[2] The Parties will be prepared to discuss the matter of expert evidence at the next CMC. The Respondent shall raise the question of whether the Claimant in *Skuppah* will seek to use expert evidence on the adequacy of compensation at the time of the taking with counsel for the Claimant in *Skuppah* prior to the next CMC.

[3] The Parties will consider whether and how to best coordinate this Claim with that in *Skuppah* prior to the next CMC, including the possibility of creating a record common to both claims and considerations of timing and sequencing of hearings.

[4] A Notice pursuant to Section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* shall be sent to the Skuppah Indian Band, Boothroyd Indian Band, Boston Bar First Nation, Kanaka Bar Indian Band, Nicomen Indian Band, Spuzzum First Nation, Cook's Ferry Indian Band and Lytton First Nation in this matter, upon the Parties' request.
