**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on September 26, 2014, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they had each produced a list of documents. They are now in the process of reviewing the documents with a view to identifying questions of privilege or other concerns (which they will also make known to each other) by the next CMC.

[2] The Claimant confirmed that it has retained Mr. James Morrison as an expert and has provided the Respondent with a copy of Mr. Morrison's curriculum vitae and a general description of the areas in which he is expected to give opinion evidence. The Claimant indicated that it intends to call its expert as a witness at the hearing and to enter his report into evidence. The Respondent reported that it will likely require a responding expert and that it will commence the retainer process but preparation of its expert's report will not likely commence until the report of the Claimant's expert has been produced.

[3] The Parties are working cooperatively on a protocol in respect of the development of oral history evidence. They expect to have agreement on the protocol by the next CMC. The Claimant identified Hartland Goodtrack and Wayne Goodwill as likely oral history witnesses although it reserves the right not to call them and to call other witnesses. The Claimant is in the process of interviewing these witnesses and will confirm its full list of intended oral history witnesses by the time of the next CMC.

[4] Time lines for the preparation of an Agreed Statement of Facts, an Agreed Statement of Issues and a Common Book of Documents will be considered at the next CMC.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on January 30, 2015, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
