ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held on December 19, 2013, at 11:00 A.M., Mountain Time (Edmonton, Alberta).

- [1] The Registry shall contact the Parties with respect to:
- a. The technological requirements for an electronic record of documents;

- b. expert reports;
- c. a Common Book of Documents,;
- d. Transcripts;
- e. An Agreed Statement of Facts;
- f. Memoranda of Fact and Law; and,
- g. Book of Authorities.

[2] The Claimant shall notify the Respondent on or before January 10, 2014, of which reports exchanged during the course of the advancement of the claim at the Specific Claims Branch they intent to rely upon in these proceedings.

[3] The Claimant shall deliver to the Respondent on or before March 7, 2014, the particulars of the basis, as related to the grounds for the claim, for the Claimant's reliance on the matters set out in paragraph 12 of the Declaration of Claim.

[4] The Respondent shall respond to the Claimant's particulars no later than twenty-one (21) days after having received such particulars. If unable to do so, the Respondent may, by way of e-mail to the Registry and Claimant, provide reason(s) and request an extension of time.

[5] The Parties shall consider whether the issues arising out the pleadings that Treaty rights are not frozen in time and that equitable compensation is due and may be tried as discrete issues in advance of a hearing on the merits, and be ready for discussion at the next CMC.

[6] The next CMC shall be held on April 16, 2014, by videoconference. The Registry will contact the Parties to set down a time. CMC shall discuss future timelines, and shall revisit the issue of oral history evidence.
