ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 10, 2015 at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent shall advise the proposed Intervenor, Claimant and the Tribunal of its position with respect to the Application to Intervene on or before **November 20, 2015**. Should the Respondent's position be that they agree with the terms of the intervention as discussed at the CMC, an Order will be issued granting the intervention with the terms. If the Tribunal has to make a decision based on competing views another CMC will be scheduled.

[2] The Claimant and Respondent shall produce an initial Common List of Documents and provide the Tribunal with a Joint Status Report on the Common List of Documents on or before **January 29, 2016**.

[3] The Parties shall engage in discussions with a view to clarifying their respective positions in relation to both islands at issue in this Claim. Should the Parties require assistance from the Tribunal to clarify the issues, they may request a CMC. A clarification of positions will inform the scope of the issues before the Tribunal and assist in the eventual preparation of a Draft Statement of Issues.

[4] The following items will be discussed at the next CMC:

- (a) a timetable for an Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues,
- (b) a further discussion of the Common List of Documents,
- (c) intentions of the Claimant with respect to the introduction of oral history evidence,
- (d) the possibility of mediation;
- (e) whether the Claimant intends to introduce expert evidence; and
- (f) whether the issues of validity and compensation will be bifurcated.

[5] The next CMC will be held in early **February, 2016**. The Parties shall contact the Registry with their availability at their earliest convenience.
