ENDORSEMENT

Honourable W.L. Whalen

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 24, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties report that document production is complete unless further documents come to light through the work of experts.

[2] The Respondent confirms that there is no longer a conflict of interest with regards to counsel.

[3] The Respondent provided the Claimant with a draft oral history protocol on April 17, 2015, which the Claimant has not yet had the opportunity to consider. The Parties are directed to finalize a protocol by the next CMC and be prepared to discuss details of how, when and where oral history might be received.

[4] The Claimant reports it has identified potential oral history witnesses and is about to start interviewing them. The Claimant is unable to indicate at this point how many of these witnesses will be able to offer relevant evidence. Claimant's counsel undertook to be prepared by the next CMC to identify the oral history witnesses it intends to call and to indicate when Will-Say statements of those witnesses will be produced.

[5] The Claimant reports that it has engaged an expert, whose report is expected to be complete and filed by October 15, 2015. The Claimant is directed to identify the expert and describe the area of expertise involved to the Respondent before the next CMC so that the Respondent may commence the process of obtaining approval to engage a responding report if need be.

[6] The Claimant undertook to deliver a draft Agreed Statement of Facts to the Respondent by June 1, 2015. The Parties are encouraged to commence preparation of a Common Book of Documents so that completion could be expedited once expert reports had been received.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on September 3, 2015, at 11:30 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
