A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 16, 2014, at 11:15 A.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent shall provide a draft Bifurcation Order on or before April 28, 2014 to the Claimant and Registry.

[2] The Claimant will, not later than May 15, 2014, advise the Respondent if they intend to introduce in evidence at the validity phase of proceedings any expert or other reports that were presented in the Specific Claims Branch process, and provide copies of the same. The Respondent will advise the Claimant whether they oppose the introduction of all or any of the reports. If opposed, the onus will be on the Respondent to file an Application challenging the admissibility of the reports.

[3] The Respondent is granted leave to file the above application.

[4] The Claimant shall provide a List of Documents to the Respondent on or before June 30, 2014.

[5] The Respondent shall provide a List of Documents one month after receiving the Claimant's List of Documents.

[6] The Parties shall provide a Joint Status Report, on or before July 15, 2014. If they are unable to agree on the contents of a Joint Status Report, the Parties shall file separate Status Reports on or before July 15, 2014. Parties may request a CMC at that time if required.

[7] The contents of the letters from Claimant's Counsel dated March 19, 2014, and March 28, 2014, satisfy the Respondent's request for particulars.

[8] The Parties shall inform the Registry in writing of the dates in September, 2014, on which all are available for a CMC.
