**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 28, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] A bifurcation order on the terms proposed by the Parties was issued on May 29, 2015.

[2] It is noted, for the record, that in response to the Respondent's request, counsel for the Claimant stated that this present claim is not a Treaty Land Entitlement (TLE) claim and that this statement is without prejudice to the Claimant's ability to bring forward a TLE claim.

[3] The Respondent shall retain an expert and obtain an expert report. It is ordered that the Respondent's expert report shall be filed and served on or before **August 28, 2015**. If the Respondent cannot meet the August 28, 2015, deadline it shall advise the Tribunal on or before **June 30, 2015**, at which time a CMC will be scheduled as soon as possible.

[4] Counsel for the Respondent shall instruct its expert to consider road allowances. The question of whether road allowances reduce reserve acreage will be revisited after expert analysis is undertaken in order to determine whether this remains in issue.

[5] The Claimant shall provide the Tribunal with the plan of survey that shows the road allowance.

[6] The Claimant shall determine if it will rely on expert evidence to counter the Respondent's expert report once it is received.
