ENDORSEMENT

Honourable W.L. Whalen

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 20, 2015, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties confirmed that production of documents is complete, subject to further documents being discovered and produced by experts in preparation of reports. At this point there are no objections to any documents produced, nor any questions of privilege.

[2] The Parties reported that they had agreed to an oral history protocol, a copy of which has been filed with the Tribunal. The Claimant confirmed that it would present two oral history witnesses, namely: Hartland Goodtrack and Councillor Dave Ogle. Councillor Ogle will introduce the witnesses and provide the necessary context and background information in respect of the status of the witnesses and their ability to provide oral history evidence. Councillor Ogle will also provide direct evidence. No interpreters will be required.

[3] The Claimant indicated that oral history Will-Say statements will be delivered to the Respondent on or before **May 8, 2015**. Copies will also be filed with the Tribunal in aid of the conduct of an oral history evidence hearing to receive this evidence in advance of a validity hearing. The Parties are agreed that the oral history evidence hearing should be conducted at the Wood Mountain First Nation Band Hall outside of Assiniboia, Saskatchewan, and it was tentatively agreed that a one-day hearing would take place on September 29, 2015. The Registry was provided with appropriate contact information and will confirm the date if arrangements can be made.

[4] The Claimant indicated that it still expects its historical expert's report to be completed and delivered to the Respondent by early to mid-summer 2015. The Respondent will decide if it requires a responding report when it has had the opportunity to review the Claimant's expert's report.

[5] The Agreed Statements of Facts and Issues, and a Common Book of Documents cannot be completed until receipt of experts' reports and oral history Will-Say statements. The Parties indicated that they would start work on these compilations and Statements in order to facilitate their sooner completion.

[6] The Parties shall complete their Common List of Documents on or before the next CMC

[7] The location and dates of the validity hearing will be considered at the next CMC.

[8] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **September 8, 2015**, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
