Pursuant to Rule 10 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure*, SOR/2011-119, and by consent of the Parties, **THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS that**:

- a. The hearing of this Claim will proceed in separate stages;
