A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person on July 23, 2014, at 10:00 A.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver).

[1] The Parties shall discuss and provide the Registry with a letter identifying the First Nations to whom a notice pursuant to Section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* should be provided.

[2] The Respondent shall produce a second list of documents on or before August 29, 2014.

[3] With respect to the Excessive Width Report, the Claimant is content in relying upon the documents appended to the same, which will be included in the Common Book of Documents, an approach agreed to by the Crown. The Claimant does not wish to make an application to have the report introduced in its entirety although it disagreed with the objection of settlement privilege raised by the Crown in relation to the same.

[4] The Parties shall advise the Tribunal of their availability for the week of September 2, 2014, and September 29, 2014, for a site visit. The Claimant shall contact the Registry about the details for timing.

[5] The next CMC shall take place on or before October 31, 2014. The Parties are to jointly advise the Registry of a date between now and then on which they would be available. Should either Party consider it necessary to have a CMC at anytime, they are to advise the Tribunal.
