ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 20, 2017, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall update the Tribunal and Respondent in writing on or before **May 8, 2017**, if an oral history evidence hearing (“hearing”) is feasible for the last two weeks of June 2017. However, if it becomes clear before this date that a hearing is or is not feasible, the Claimant is asked to inform the Tribunal of this decision as soon as possible.

[2] If a hearing end of June is feasible, the Claimant shall inform the Tribunal and Respondent of the chosen location and dates during this two week period on or before **May 8, 2017**. The Claimant shall also inform the Registry of the name of the interpreter agreed to by the Parties at least 45 calendar days before the start of the hearing, as already set out by the Parties in the draft *Protocol for Elder Testimony and Oral History* dated March 16, 2017 (“Protocol”). Thus, if the hearing were to start on Wednesday, June 22, 2017, the name of the interpreter should also be provided in writing to the Registry on or before **May 8, 2017**.

[3] If a hearing end of June is feasible, the Claimant shall also make best efforts to get Will-Says underway for production to the Respondent as soon as possible. The Parties’ submitted draft Protocol may be amended accordingly in order to accommodate this hearing sometime in the last two weeks of June 2017, as is preferred by the Tribunal. The Respondent expressed the difficulty it may face if it does not receive the Will-Says on a timely basis. It was agreed that this matter will be revisited at the next CMC.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **May 18, 2017**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
