**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on September 4, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that its expert had completed a draft of the first phase of his report and that he was working on the second phase. In the course of working on this second phase, he

reported that he had discovered a large amount of new documentation that will require time to review and assess. He also plans a site visit in mid-September 2015. As a result, his report will not be finalized until sometime later, likely in the range of six to eight weeks after the site visit. The completion date of his report will be considered at the next CMC if necessary.

[2] The Claimant is to consult its expert with respect to the nature of his newly discovered documents to canvass their relevance for purposes of further production if appropriate, and to produce those documents to the Respondent. The matter will be canvassed at the next CMC.

[3] The Claimant indicated that it intends to present three or four oral history witnesses. The Claimant is to identify the oral history witnesses it intends to present and to provide the Respondent with Will-Says on or before **December 14, 2015**.

[4] The oral history Hearing will be held in the Claimant's community on April 14 and 15, 2016 commencing at 10:00 A.M. The Parties indicated that interpretation will be required and they have an agreed list of acceptable interpreters, which they have provided to the Tribunal. The Claimant is also directed to provide the Registry with the name and coordinates of a contact person to facilitate the conduct of the oral history Hearing.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on December 14, 2015, at 2:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).
