ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 14, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that its expert report was anticipated to be complete and produced by the end of January, 2016. The Respondent reported that it had retained an expert to prepare a

responding report and that it would identify the expert to the Claimant by the end of December, 2015. The Respondent expects that its expert's report will not be completed until approximately the end of April, 2016. The completion of expert reports will be reviewed at the next CMC.

[2] The documents discovered by the Claimant's expert in preparing his report are to be produced to the Respondent by the end of December, 2015.

[3] The Claimant indicated that it had identified four oral history witnesses that it intended to present at the oral history evidence hearing scheduled in the Claimant's community on April 14 and 15, 2016. Will-Say statements have been prepared for these proposed witnesses and will be produced to the Respondent by the end of December, 2015.

[4] The bifurcation of this Claim into validity and compensation phases will be discussed at the next CMC.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **June 7, 2016**, at 12:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).
