A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person on October 9, 2015, at 1:00 P.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver).

[1] The Claimant shall extract, without removing, the particular allegations set out in its pleading, that in its view, support the plea of an exploitative bargain. If the Claimant chooses to add something in what has already been provided to the Crown since this matter was last discussed, they shall do so. This issue may be revisited upon an application for further or better

particulars, or preferably and as agreed by the parties, after the delivery of the anticipated expert reports.

[2] The Respondent was to provide the Claimant with any additional disclosure documents by **October 30, 2015**.

[3] The Respondent shall provide its particulars on its plea of acquiescence and contributory negligence on or before **November 13, 2015**.

[4] The Parties shall report jointly, on the status of the preparation of the Common Book of Documents on or before **November 30, 2015**. The Parties may wish to identify disagreements, if extant, individually. If a CMC is required with a view to resolving disagreements in respect of the Common Book of Documents, the Parties may contact the Registry.

[5] The Parties shall contact the Tribunal to provide their availability for a CMC to take place before the end of January, 2016.
