A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 6, 2016, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that its expert expects to deliver his report by July 31, 2016. The Respondent indicated that it had identified an expert and was in the process of engaging him.

[2] The Parties confirmed that they are ready to proceed with the oral history evidence hearing commencing on June 15, 2016. The Claimant intends to put seven elders forward to testify. An agreed upon interpreter has been arranged to assist one of the witnesses if necessary.

[3] Counsel for the Claimant shall advise the Registry prior to the commencement of the oral history hearing as to how oral history witnesses will be presented to the Tribunal and how each witness will affirm a special obligation to tell the truth; i.e. on a Bible, via an oath, or through a custom specific to the traditions of the witness.

[4] Timelines for hearing expert witnesses, the possibility of proceeding with a settlement conference process and the scheduling of a validity hearing will be considered at the next CMC.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **August 30, 2016**, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
