ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on February 23, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent shall provide the Claimant with a draft Agreed Statement of Facts, Agreed Statement of Issues and a Common Book of Documents on or before **May 1, 2017**.

[2] The Claimant shall make best efforts to provide its drafts in turn to the Respondent on or before **June 5, 2017**.

[3] The Tribunal encourages the Parties to consider the option of mediation now that the expert surveyor reports have been finalized.

[4] The Parties confirmed that neither oral history evidence nor further expert reports would be required beyond the expert surveyor reports already filed with the Tribunal. As such, the Parties are also encouraged to consider when a potential hearing date for expert evidence and/or oral submissions might be held.

[5] The Parties shall file a Joint Status Report during the week of June 5, 2017, reporting on all of the above. Based on the contents of the report, a CMC may be scheduled during the weeks of July 3 or July 10, 2017, or its scheduling may be postponed.
