ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person on May 20, 2014, at 10:00 A.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver).

[1] The Parties shall provide a Joint Status Report on or before June 30, 2014, which will progress to date respecting:

- a. an Agreed Statement of Facts;

- b. a Common Book of Documents;
- c. a Common List of Issues;
- d. filing dates for the Claimant's Memorandum of Fact and Law, the Respondent's Memorandum of Fact and Law and the Claimant's Reply, which are to take into account the hearing date for submissions;
- e. a schedule for the hearing of oral history evidence, including the delivery of Will-Say and Will-Ask statements;
- f. a schedule for the anticipated site visit; and
- g. whether the Parties have agreed on which principles emanating from the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* would govern compensation in the event that the Claim is found valid.

[2] The Registry shall communicate to the Parties the Tribunal's availability for late September and early October in order for them to coordinate the hearing of oral history evidence schedule in their June 30, 2014, Joint Status Report.

[3] The hearing of legal arguments is projected to be heard in Vancouver, in January, 2015.

[4] The Parties shall be prepared for a further discussion on the causation and contribution issue at the next CMC.

[5] The Parties shall advise the Registry of their availability for the next CMC, which is expected to take place in early July, 2014.
