A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 26, 2014, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent shall provide the Claimant with its Expert Report by **mid-December 2014**.

[2] The Claimant shall provide the Respondent with its Response to the Respondent's List of Documents, and shall further advise as to whether supplementary documents are required, providing a list of such supplementary documents if possible, on or before **January 16, 2015**.

[3] An evidentiary hearing is tentatively booked **April 13 to 17, 2015** subject to change pending confirmation of availability and other procedural matters, including the Respondent's Response to the Claimant's Expert Report and Siska Indian Band's involvement, if any.

[4] The next CMC will be held in person in Vancouver on Friday, **February 13, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver)**, pending confirmation of Respondent Counsel's availability, where the Parties shall:

- a. report on the status of the Common List of Documents, Common List of Issues, Common Book of Documents and Oral History testimony or other *viva voce* testimony;
- b. revisit the tentative hearing date of April 13-17, 2015 for the evidentiary phase and the location of the hearing; and,
- c. discuss whether the hearing of evidence shall take place in the Claimant's territory, the Claimant's Counsel having discussed the same with their client.
