**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 18, 2014, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The hearing of the application to amend the Declaration of Claim shall be heard in Vancouver on September 10, 2014, at 10:00 A.M., Pacific Time at the Federal Court, 701 Georgia Street.

[2] The hearing of submissions on the validity of the Claim originally scheduled for September 10, 2014, is rescinded and shall be re-scheduled after the hearing of the application to amend the Declaration of Claim.

[3] The Claimant shall further amend paragraph 64 of their proposed Amended Declaration of Claim. If the Parties are unable to resolve the issue with paragraph 64, they shall advise the Tribunal prior to the September hearing so that a CMC may be scheduled.

[4] The Claimant shall have the draft of further amendment to the Respondent on or before July 25, 2014.

[5] The Claimant shall file a Memorandum of Fact and Law on or before August 1, 2014, pursuant to the request for an extension of time on consent dated July 31, 2014, and granted by the Honourable Justice Slade. The Respondent shall have their responding Memorandum of Fact and Law filed on or before August 29, 2014. Any Reply shall be filed on or before September 5, 2014.

[6] The Parties may make changes to schedule for exchange of submissions as long as the documents above are filed on or before September 8, 2014.
