A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 6, 2016, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they had filed an Agreed Statement of Facts and that they were working cooperatively in the preparation of a Common Book of Documents, which cannot be finalized until the experts' reports are completed, including the experts' possible identification of

further documents. The Parties assured the Tribunal that they would continue to work actively toward the completion of a Common Book of Documents.

[2] The Claimant reported that its expert report had been delayed pending completion of the Agreed Statement of Facts and an advanced state of identification of documents. The Claimant's expert report will be produced by **February 24, 2017**.

[3] The Claimant will provide a list of non-expert witnesses that it intends to call, together with Will-Say statements of expected testimony to the Respondent, by **April 28, 2017**.

[4] There will be a hearing of expert and non-expert witnesses at Anacra, British Columbia commencing on November 13, 2017, and continuing through to November 17, 2017, as necessary.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **March 10, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
