REVISED ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Hearing on the Application was held in person on June 26, 2015, at 10:00 A.M., in Edmonton.

[1] The hearing of the Application to amend the Declaration of Claim is adjourned *sine die* until a decision is rendered on the Respondent’s Application on *res judicata*.

[2] The Respondent is granted leave to file an Application seeking a determination of the question of *res judicata*. The Respondent will file the Application in writing.

[3] The Respondent shall serve the Claimant with the Application and any material relied on in support on or before **July 10, 2015**.

[4] The Claimant shall file a Response and any material relied on in support within 2 weeks of receipt of the Application.

[5] The Respondent shall file a Memorandum of Fact and Law within 14 days following receipt of the Claimant's Response. The Claimant will file its Memorandum of Fact and Law within 14 days thereafter. The Respondent may, within 7 days, file a brief reply, strictly limited to anything new that arises in the Claimant's response.

[6] The Parties may agree to vary the above schedule, and will file any varied dates with the Registry.

[7] The hearing of the Respondent's Application will be held in person before the Honourable Harry Slade in Edmonton in **September 2015**.

[8] A copy of the Settlement Agreement will be filed with the Tribunal. An endorsement will be issued to seal the Settlement Agreement upon receipt.

[9] The previous deadline of September 1, 2015 for the Agreed Statement of Facts is waived.

[10] The Parties shall prepare a Common Book of Documents prior to the hearing on the merits, for the hearing of the Application. Duplication of documents is to be avoided.
