**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 21, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties report that document production is complete, with the exception of two reports, which will be included in the Common Book of Documents. The Parties are in the process of redacting parts of the reports that they have agreed will not be included. The report

documents are to be ready and produced by **May 29, 2015**. The Common Book of Documents can then be completed.

[2] The Parties confirmed that they do not expect to present expert evidence.

[3] The Parties report that they have agreed to an oral history protocol. The Parties shall file the agreed oral history protocol with the Tribunal on or before **June 2, 2015**.

[4] Claimant's counsel reports that scheduled interviews with two potential witnesses have fallen through. The Claimant is working to reschedule the interviews, but with some difficulty. Further time is granted to allow the Claimant's counsel to meet with the potential witnesses. The Claimant shall advise on the status at the next CMC.

[5] The Claimant will file will-says with the Tribunal. A timeline for the filing of the will-says will be discussed at the next CMC.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **June 2, 2015**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa). The Parties are not required to file CMC Briefs for the next CMC.
