

Will-Say for, it would produce a Will-Say for such further witness on or before **August 31, 2015**. The Respondent reserved the right to conduct further document research and to produce further documents in response to any matters raised in any further Will-Says produced by the Claimant.

[2] The Parties have filed an agreed Oral History Protocol.

[3] The Parties reported that they had agreed to the contents of a Common Book of Documents, subject to document production that the Respondent may make in response to further oral history Will-Says. By agreement of the Parties, the Common Book of Documents shall be completed and filed on or before **November 28, 2015**.

[4] The Parties reported that they were in the late stages of completion of an Agreed Statement of Facts, which will be filed on or before **January 29, 2016**.

[5] The Parties are agreed that a two-day hearing will be held during the week of May 16, 2016 at the Ahousaht Community or at Tofino British Columbia to receive the Claimant's proposed oral history evidence. The Parties are directed to confirm hearing dates and location with the Registry on or before **December 1, 2015**.

[6] By agreement of the Parties they are to file written submissions on fact and law for the validity hearing phase as follows:

- (a) Claimant's Memorandum of Fact and Law on or before **June 17, 2016**;
- (b) Respondent's Memorandum of Fact and Law on or before **July 15, 2016**;
- (c) Claimant's Reply on or before **July 29, 2016**.

[7] The hearing of the validity phase of the Claim will be held on two days early in September 2016 at a location to be determined. The Registry is directed to schedule a CMC by teleconference to take place during the month of January 2016 to fix the dates for the validity hearing.

[8] The Parties are each directed to file a written status report on or before **September 30, 2015** to report on their progress. If necessary, the Parties are to advise in this report if they require a CMC.
