**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 28, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent stated that it had received a draft expert report from the Claimant, and elaborated on why it required additional underlying data before it could understand the report and instruct its own expert. The Respondent indicated that it had initiated further research in respect of alternate logging road rights of way available or under development at the relevant

time, and it had identified gaps in its existing research. The Respondent indicated that its additional research includes making Freedom of Information requests to the Province of British Columbia for documentation.

[2] The Claimant stated that it had provided all the necessary underlying data and clarifications requested.

[3] The Tribunal observed that the question was too complex for resolution in this CMC and urged the Parties to redouble their efforts to work cooperatively. The Tribunal expects the Parties to report on their progress regarding the matter at the next CMC.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **May 12, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
