A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 6, 2016 at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The week of January 9, 2017, is tentatively reserved for the oral history evidence hearing. The Claimants shall provide statements of qualifications of their witnesses as elders and as oral

historians for the communities, as well as a summary of the proposed evidence and the source of the knowledge of the proposed evidence on or before **December 9, 2016**. The Respondent shall raise any preliminary objections to the admissibility of the oral history evidence on or before **December 22, 2016**.

[2] The Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation doesn't foresee any issues with holding the hearing in the week of January 9, 2017, but will confirm with the Tribunal.

[3] The Claimant Iskatewizaagegan No. 39 Independent First Nation will confirm with the Tribunal if there are any health concerns with any of their elder witnesses. If there are such concerns, the oral history evidence hearing for the Iskatewizaagegan No. 39 Independent First Nation shall take place in the first week of November 2016, and a CMC will be scheduled prior to the hearing to discuss further details.
