A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 11, 2016, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it had received the Respondent's expert survey report and reviewed it. That report contains contradictions to the Claimant's counsel's understanding of certain facts as he understood them. As a result, he must seek instructions and review the

proposed oral history evidence more closely. The Claimant may require a responding expert

survey report of its own.

[2] The Claimant reported that it had located a survey post referred to in one of the oral

history Will-Say statements. The Claimant will provide the Respondent with a photograph of the

post and its GPS coordinates. Claimant's counsel has been unable to reach his client's principal

yet to do so.

[3] The Claimant expects to advise the Respondent by the end of the first week of May 2016

about whether the Claimant will require a survey expert and also to provide a photograph of the

survey post and its GPS coordinates.

[4] The Parties are agreed that the present dates for the hearing of oral history evidence and

the validity phase should be kept. Whether and when a separate expert hearing will take place

will be discussed at the next CMC.

[5] At the request of the Parties it is directed that the Common Book of Documents be

completed by May 31, 2016 and be filed on or before June 17, 2016. The deadline of August

26, 2016 for the filing of the Agreed Statement of Facts will be revisited at the next CMC, if

necessary. The Parties reported that they are working cooperatively on completion of these

documents.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **June 7, 2016** at 1:00 P.M., Eastern

Time (Ottawa).
