ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 12, 2016, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] On consent of the Parties, the Claimant may serve and file its Amended Declaration of Claim. The Tribunal directs that any such amendment shall be filed not later than **January 31, 2017**.

[2] The Respondent shall serve and file its Amended Response within 30 days of the filing of the Amended Declaration of Claim with the Tribunal.


[3] The Claimant has provided the Respondent with Part 1 of its expert report and anticipates that Part 2 may be completed in March 2017 or later. The Respondent anticipates having its initial expert report completed by the end of January 2017. The Tribunal advised the Parties that barring a valid reason for delay, any further responsive expert reports should take no longer than 6 weeks to be exchanged following the date of the receipt of the initial expert report.

[4] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties shall jointly set aside dates for a hearing to be held in September and/or October 2017, and not later than October 2017. The Claimant has advised that it would like to have the hearing take place in the community. Consideration shall also be given to dates and location for a potential expert evidence hearing, and whether it will be held in advance of or in the same week as the oral submission hearing.

[5] The following items will be discussed at the next CMC:

- a) When the Claimant expects further document production to occur;
- b) Progress on the Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues;
- c) Dates for delivery of initial expert reports and responsive expert reports, if any, as well as supplementary expert reports, if any; and
- d) Target dates for the oral submission hearing and expert evidence hearing.

[3] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **February 17, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
