ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in Tofino, British Columbia on July 12, 2016, at 9:30 A.M., Pacific Time.

[1] The Parties filed a Common Book of Documents and Consent Agreement on Documents with the Tribunal on June 17, 2016. There are a few contested documents which have not been included in the Common Book of Documents. The Parties are hopeful that they will be able to

resolve this issue and submit any additional documents at the validity hearing in the usual manner, and if not, they will be dealt with by a formal application.

[2] Claimant's counsel reported that he had retained a survey expert who he expects will require 3 months to complete his report because of the time necessary to review the Respondent's expert's extensive report, to complete onsite work and to do related archival research. If the Claimant decides to use the report and to file it, the Respondent will require time to review the report and to consider whether it will require a rebuttal report from its expert.

[3] The Pre-Hearing Conference scheduled for September 9, 2016, and the validity hearing scheduled for October 5 and 6, 2016, are adjourned.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 6, 2016**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
