ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 6, 2016, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that questions regarding the admissibility of some documents had been resolved. A supplementary Common Book of Documents will be filed in due course.

[2] The Parties also reported that preparation of the transcript of oral history had been delayed because of difficulty in transcribing the recorded testimony. A member of the Claimant First Nation is assisting with spelling issues.

[3] The Claimant reported that its expert has been unable to complete his report, in part because the expert wishes to review the oral history transcript before completing the report. Subject to availability of the oral history transcript, the expert expects to present a draft report to the Claimant by the end of November 2016. The Respondent may require a supplementary expert report in reply to the Claimant's upon reviewing the Claimant's expert's report.

[4] The Parties agreed that an Agreed Statement of Facts cannot be completed until the oral history transcript has been completed and reviewed, and also until expert reports have been completed, exchanged and reviewed. It is premature to consider scheduling a validity hearing date.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **February 1, 2017**, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
