ENDORSEMENT

Honourable W.L. Whalen

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 11, at 1:20 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties have exchanged the Land Appraisal Expert Report and the Land Appraisal Expert Response Report with each other. The Claimant shall provide the Respondent with their Land Appraisal Expert Reply Report on or before **August 21, 2015**. It is directed that copies of all the Land Appraisal Expert Reports exchanged among the Parties be filed with the Tribunal on or before **August 31, 2015**.

[2] The Claimant advised that the draft “Bring Forward” Report they received from their expert was inadequate and unacceptable, to the point that they expect the need to retain a new expert. Claimant's counsel has already consulted a new and very experienced expert, who would be able to deliver a report by the end of August 2015, subject to possible funding issues for said report.

[3] The Parties agreed to go ahead with the Hearing of the Land Appraisal Expert Evidence scheduled for September 21 - 25, 2015 in Vancouver, British Columbia, commencing at 10:00 A.M. on September 21, 2015.

[4] The Tribunal directs that the Intervener shall be permitted to make reply submissions during the hearing as follows:

- a) Limited to a proper reply (i.e., relating only to new matters raised by the Respondent in its arguments);
- b) No more than five pages of written argument, and;
- c) No more than ten minutes of oral submissions.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on August 18, 2015, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa), to canvass the progress of expert reports, and to consider the timing of the hearing of bring forward evidence and final submissions.
