ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 5, 2016, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it had just received the Joan Holmes & Associates Categorization Report and a Revised Common Book of Documents, all of which it expects to deliver to the Respondent in the next day or two.

[2] The Respondent indicated that it would require some time to review the Categorization Report and that it may have to engage professional help to do so. Because the Report may clarify or add to questions the Respondent had about the labelling of expenses as “Allowable” and “Not Allowable”, the Respondent agreed to communicate its questions about the Report after it had had the opportunity to review the Report closely. The Respondent would then respond.

[3] The Respondent will also review the Revised Common Book of Documents and communicate any concerns it might have in that regard to the Claimant.

[4] The Respondent reported that it had been drafting an Agreed Statement of Facts, but it could not do more until it had reviewed the Categorization Report.

[5] The Respondent indicated that after it has reviewed the Categorization Report it will be in a position to decide whether it will require its own expert.

[6] The matters discussed above will be reviewed at the next CMC, which will be held by teleconference on **June 6, 2016** at 1:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).
