**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on August 29, 2016, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it had requested and received from the Respondent, particulars clarifying disputed expenditures.

[2] The Respondent is still in the process of contracting its expert to prepare a responding report to that produced by the Claimant's expert. The Respondent expects the contract to be in place by September 2016, and the report to be completed by the end of January 2017, at the latest.

[3] The Parties are working co-operatively on the preparation of an Agreed Statement of Facts and a Common Book of Documents. They have exchanged a draft Agreed Statement of Facts and proposed list of documents. The Parties reported that they are meeting on August 30, 2016, to try to resolve differences on the proposed Common Book of Documents and other matters. One of the questions is the need to include documentation in relation to expenditures that are not disputed. Progress will be reviewed at the next CMC.

[4] The Respondent reported that it intends to call Sherry Daniels (an INAC employee) as a witness to testify about the legislation and policies of Canada in effect during certain periods of time and applied to accounting procedures in respect of classifying/recording First Nations expenditures. The Respondent is considering whether the witness will be presented as an expert or lay witness.

[5] The Parties shall consider where and when to hold a hearing. The Claimant shall advise if it would like to hold the hearing in the community.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **December 6, 2016**, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
