A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 1, 2016, at 1:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent reported that its experts were concerned that they could not provide a full or helpful report until the Tribunal had decided upon a historic value. The Claimant expressed concern about delay in the hearing if an adjournment was granted.

[2] In the interests of efficiency, minimizing complexity and causing unreasonable delay should the expert opinions not fully or adequately address the Tribunal's conclusions on historical value, the Tribunal reluctantly adjourns the dates earlier committed to hear the experts from April 25 to April 29, 2016.
