ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 18, 2015, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall advise the Tribunal on or before **November 25, 2015** whether or not they are able to agree on a timetable for the compensation phase of proceedings. If an agreement cannot be reached, the Parties shall each file a letter with the Tribunal, copying one another,

indicating their positions with respect to the timetable's dates and the Tribunal will decide on the appropriate timetable.

[2] The proposed timetable shall include:

- a) timing of the delivery of the Respondent's Expert Report,
- b) filing of the Claimant's Responsive Expert Report, if any,
- c) filing of the Respondent's Memorandum of Fact and Law in Response to the Claimant's Memorandum of Fact and Law regarding compensation filed on October 2, 2015,
- d) Respondent's initial Memorandum of Fact and Law on the discrete issue of contingencies,
- e) Claimant's Reply submissions on the Respondent's Memorandum on contingencies; and,
- f) Respondent's Reply submissions, if any.

[3] The Parties shall identify the dates of their availability for a hearing on compensation at the end of March, 2016. The Parties shall discuss and inform the Tribunal of their preference of a hearing venue. If the Claimant elects to introduce a responding expert report, hearing dates may be revisited at a subsequent CMC.
