**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 5, 2017, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent reported that it had provided all requested additional documentary productions to the Claimant last week.

[2] The Claimant indicated that it was now in a position to finalize its desired amendments to its Declaration of Claim by April 21, 2017. The Claimant shall provide its proposed Amended Declaration of Claim to the Respondent on or before **April 21, 2017**.

[3] The Respondent shall indicate to the Claimant and Tribunal whether it consents to the filing of the Amended Declaration of Claim on or before **May 5, 2017**.

[4] If the Amended Declaration of Claim is to be filed on consent, the Tribunal will issue an Order on consent (1) granting leave to the Claimant to file and serve its Amended Declaration of Claim on or shortly after May 5, 2017; and (2) indicating that the Respondent shall file its Amended Response with the Tribunal within 30 days of having been served with the Amended Declaration of Claim (Rule 42).

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **June 22, 2017**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa). Depending on the status of the potential amended pleadings at this time, the Parties may be asked to provide an update on the Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues.
