A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 11, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent is granted leave to file an Application with the Tribunal to bifurcate the Claim into validity and compensation phases on or before **April 27, 2017**.

[2] The Claimant will make best efforts to file its Response by May 5, 2017 but no later than by **May 8, 2017** (Rule 35).

[3] The hearing on the above Application will be held by teleconference on **May 10, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[4] The Parties confirmed that the Oral History Protocol will be filed with the Tribunal following this CMC. The Claimant indicated that the process to select Elders who may testify may start in the coming months. A meeting of Elders that had been recently scheduled was cancelled due to an Elder having passed away.

[5] The Parties shall file their more “final Joint Plan of Proceeding” with the Tribunal on or before the hearing on the Application to be held on May 10, 2017 (recognizing the outstanding bifurcation issue in the meantime may complicate some dates).
