A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in Edmonton, Alberta, on September 5, 2013, at 9:30 A.M., Mountain Time (Edmonton).

- [1] The Parties will submit a Joint Report to the Tribunal by October 31, 2013;
- [2] The Joint Report will include an update as to:

- a) The Status of progress towards completing document production and establishing the Common Book of Documents;
- b) Whether an initial draft of the Agreed Statement of Facts has been provided by the Crown to the Claimant as agreed and the status progress towards completing the Agreed Statement of Facts;
- c) The Claimant's position on use of the existing research reports previously submitted by the Claimant in the Specific Claims process;
- d) The Crown's position in response to [2] c);
- e) To the extent an agreement has been reached between the Parties as to use of existing reports, confirmation that the expert who prepared the report is available to provide evidence at the hearing, if required;
- f) Whether the Parties are able to reach agreement as to the principles of compensation which would apply in the event a shortfall in Treaty Land Entitlement is found by the Tribunal and, in particular, whether the Parties agree as to which subsection(s) of section 20(1) of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act*, if any, would apply to the assessment of compensation for such a shortfall; and
- g) If the Parties are not able to reach agreement as to the principles of compensation which would apply in the event a shortfall in Treaty Land Entitlement if found by the Tribunal, when, relative to the valuation hearing, the Parties would like the issue of the applicable compensation principles to be determined.

[3] The next CMC will take place on November 21, 2013, by videoconference.
