**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on February 27, 2014, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant confirmed that it is not challenging the validity of the February 12, 1952, easement at issue in these proceedings. Therefore, Notices under Section 22 of the *Act* are not necessary.

[2] The Claimant has requested production of a broad range of documents relating to easements, rights of way, leases and other related interests in land entered into between Canada and the Province of Manitoba in the years 1947 through 1955. The Parties have asked for time to discuss this request with a view to narrowing it or facilitating the conduct of an application. The issue will be revisited at the next CMC.

[3] The Claimant will provide the Registry with the coordinates of a contact person for purposes of arranging a hearing in the community and accommodation for the participants when it becomes appropriate.

[4] The Claimant is in the process of identifying elders who will give oral history. This has been delayed by the recent passing away of several intended elders. The Claimant indicated that it could identify the intended elders to the Respondent within 30 days. The question of development of the oral history evidence and a protocol for that purpose will be considered at the next CMC.

[5] The next CMC will be held on Wednesday, April 2, 2014, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
