ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on March 25, 2019, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Parties advised the Tribunal that they are working towards a settlement of the Claim, and had a productive negotiation meeting on March 14, 2019.

[2] The Claimant advised the Tribunal that it has retained an appraiser to provide the Parties with a valuation of the Claim in order to facilitate settlement discussions. The Claimant further advised that, should negotiations fail, it is unlikely that oral history evidence would be called in a Tribunal proceeding.

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[3] The Notice of Application on Consent filed by the Parties on March 19, 2019, for a stay of proceedings is adjourned until the next CMC, where it will be discussed along with the question of a consent order to validity, and the sending of any Notices under section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act*;

[4] The Respondent shall file a Response to the Declaration of Claim on or before **June 3, 2019**; and,

[5] The Registry shall contact the Parties to schedule the next CMC, which is to take place as soon as is practicable after June 3, 2019.
