ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Paul Mayer

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 18, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] Further to the Joint Proposed Plan of Proceeding filed with the Tribunal on May 18, 2018, the Parties shall discuss whether this Claim shall proceed in one or two separate stages. At

present, the Claimant prefers to continue with the Claim as a whole and the Respondent is inclined to pursue bifurcation.

[2] The Claimant reported that it retained an expert historian and that it is in the process of retaining an expert appraiser. The respective reports are anticipated to be completed in the fall of 2018 and winter of 2019.

[3] The Respondent reported that it has identified a potential expert historian to respond to the Claimant's expert, but that he would not be available until January 2019. The Respondent anticipated that its expert historical report would be completed in the spring of 2019, and its expert appraisal report would be completed in the early summer of 2019.

[4] The Claimant is canvassing elders who may be witnesses in preparation for a fall oral history evidence hearing.

[5] The Parties shall advise the Tribunal in writing when they would be available for an oral history evidence hearing during the week of October 8-12, 2018 and October 15-19, 2018.

[6] The Parties shall finalize their Common Book of Documents, Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues once the expert reports are completed. Mediation may be considered at that time.

[7] The Parties shall file a revised Plan of Proceeding with the Tribunal to reflect the changes discussed at the CMC.

[8] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **September 12, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
