A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 26, 2018, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties require adjustments to the timeline set out in the Joint Status Report filed August 25, 2017.

[2] The Respondent shall file at the Tribunal and serve the Claimant with the Respondent's Valuation Report on or before **April 3, 2018**.

[3] The Claimant shall file at the Tribunal and serve the Respondent with the Claimant's responding Expert Report on or before **June 15, 2018**.

[4] The Respondent shall file at the Tribunal and serve the Claimant with the Respondent's Reply Report, if required, on or before **July 16, 2018**.

[5] The Parties have exchanged lists of documents, and the Respondent has provided the Claimant with a draft index for the Common Book of Documents (CBD). The Claimant will respond to the Respondent on or before February 28, 2018. The Parties will finalize and file the CBD with the Tribunal on or before **August 31, 2018**.

[6] The Parties shall explore the option of mediating the Claim within the Tribunal process.

[7] The Claimant does not currently plan to present oral history, and will notify the Respondent and the Tribunal if that changes.

[8] A two to four day hearing of expert evidence alone, or possibly expert evidence and oral submissions, will be set for a date no later than November 30, 2018. The Parties will provide the Registry with their preferred dates.

[9] At least five days prior to the next CMC, the Parties shall file a Joint Status Report with the Tribunal indicating: progress on an Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues; whether the Parties would like the November 2018 hearing to include oral submissions; and, if so, a timeline for the exchange of written submissions.

[10] The Registry will contact the Parties to schedule the next CMC to be held by teleconference in August 2018.
