ENDORSEMENT

Honourable William Grist

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 4, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties requested adjustments to the procedural timeline set out in the Endorsement dated February 9, 2018.

[2] An oral history evidence hearing is to be held in Port Alberni, British Columbia no later than the week of October 29, 2018. The Claimant will investigate whether a site visit is possible as well. The Parties are to contact the Registry to schedule this hearing as soon as possible.

[3] In advance of the oral history evidence hearing, the Parties shall finalize an oral history and possibly a site visit protocol, in the following manner: The Respondent will provide a draft Protocol(s) to the Claimant no later than August 1, 2018 and the Claimant will reply no later than August 30, 2018.

[4] The Claimant will have until November 1, 2018 to file its response to the Respondent's historic valuation report. If necessary, the Respondent will then have until January 1, 2019 to file any further reply.

[5] The Parties agreed to have a draft Common Book of Documents prepared by November 30, 2018.

[6] The Parties agreed that a hearing for expert evidence and oral submissions is to take place in March of 2019. Three or four days are to be set aside; the Parties will have liberty to apply to split the dates into two separate hearings. The Parties are to canvass dates and be prepared to set down exact dates for the hearing(s) at the next CMC.

[7] The Registry will contact the Parties to schedule a Pre-Hearing Conference to be held by teleconference as soon as possible sometime between September 4, 2018 and September 17, 2018. At this Pre-Hearing Conference, the Parties will be expected to discuss the agreed-upon protocol for the oral history evidence hearing, progress on expert reports and Common Book of Documents, the prospects for mediation on this file, and finalized dates for the March 2019 validity hearing.
