**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Paul Mayer**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 29, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties are negotiating compensation.

[2] The Claimants indicated that they have received from the Respondent compensation calculations for past loss of use, but not for present value. The Claimants indicated that in the past few years, a related claim for the same land was settled against the Province of Ontario. The Parties will discuss to what extent there is overlap between the Claim before the Tribunal and the claim settled with Ontario, and the potential for double compensation. If the Parties cannot reach agreement on compensation, they may require the Tribunal's assistance.

[3] At the next CMC the Parties will indicate whether they wish to have this Claim put into abeyance to allow for negotiations. The Tribunal indicated that even if the matter is put into abeyance, the Tribunal would be available to assist in resolving matters between the Parties.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **December 19, 2017**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
