**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on August 16, 2018, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant confirmed that:

- a. it does not intend to present expert or lay witness evidence at the expert evidence and validity hearing; and,

- b. it does not intend to pursue its allegation in the Declaration of Claim pursuant to the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act*, paragraph 14(1)(e), at the expert evidence and validity hearing.

[2] On or before **August 24, 2018**:

- a. the Claimant will deliver all remaining documents to the Respondent;
- b. the Claimant will deliver an updated draft of the Agreed Statement of Facts to the Respondent;
- c. the Claimant will inform the Registry of its preferred location for the expert evidence and validity hearing; and,
- d. the Respondent will notify the Registry regarding the availability of its expert for the expert evidence and validity hearing.

[3] The Respondent confirmed that it has sent all of its documents to the Claimant.

[4] The Parties intend to discuss by telephone any issues arising from the Respondent's expert report prior to the next CMC.

[5] The Parties expect to file the Agreed Statement of Facts on or before **September 17, 2018**. At the next CMC, the Parties will discuss the filing schedule for the Common Book of Documents and written submissions.

[6] If the Respondent's expert is available, the expert evidence and validity hearing will commence on October 4, 2018, and is expected to require two days.

[7] The next CMC shall be held by teleconference on **September 7, 2018** at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
