**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable William Grist**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 10, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it expected to have the few, outstanding documents in hand later on the day of the CMC, which it would provide to the Respondent. The Respondent expressed some concern about setting a date for finalization of the Common Book of Documents

because it would need time for review. The Parties shall inform the Tribunal of the status of the Common Book of Documents on or before **May 11, 2018**.

[2] A maximum of two days is expected to be required for the hearing of oral submissions on the validity of the Claim. The Claimant does not expect to call an expert or introduce evidence outside of the Common Book of Documents. After the Respondent has all documents in hand, it will decide whether it will require an expert, but at this time the Respondent does not have a mandate or instructions to retain an expert.

[3] The Parties will determine if the hearing will take place in the Claimant's community. The hearing will take place during the week of August 20, 2018, subject to reconsideration at the next CMC if the Parties have made tangible progress on resolving the Claim. The Registry will communicate with the Claimant to organize logistics.

[4] The Parties will be prepared to discuss the Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues at the next CMC. The Parties will contact the Registry with their proposed date and time for the CMC, which will be held by teleconference during the week of July 16, 2018.
